## Program Information

UCLA's Center for Community College Partnerships (CCCP) presents the **CCCP Scholars Program** for the 2010-2011 Academic Year. The goal of the program is to **motivate, inform** and **prepare** students to transfer from a California community college to selective Top Tier Research institutions such as UCLA. If selected, students in the program have access to our summer and year-long academic preparatory transfer programs which guide students through the community college experience, the application and admissions process, research and pre-graduate opportunities and career exploration.

**CCCP Scholars have a higher rate of admissions to selective institutions and are eligible for special scholarships.** The programs focus on these processes from a **social justice** and **educational equity** perspective.

## Target Participants

CCCP Scholars are students who may:

- be the **first** in their family to go to college;
- come from **low-income** backgrounds;
- and/or be from **underserved** communities.

CCCP Scholars targets students who:

- have **recently graduated from high school** and plan to enroll in a community college in the fall **OR students currently attending community college** who have not yet completed a transfer curriculum at the time of application.
- show potential for **transfer success**.
- are **non-traditional** students who have faced challenges in their academic career.

### NOTE:

1) If you have already participated in one of our summer programs, you do not need to apply to the CCCP Scholars Program as you are currently enrolled. You must, however, complete a new CCCP Scholars agreement every year.

2) If you participated in SITE and would like to participate in another summer program, you will need to re-apply.



## TO APPLY:

- 1) Review requirements and select a summer program.
- 2) Complete online application, including short answer essays.
- 3) Submit required additional documents:
  - Recommendation form
  - Course Schedule form
  - Transcripts
