Finding Funding

- ❖ GCC Foundation
 - Beginning in 2010, the GCC Foundation set up a grants program to fund campus projects
 - Grants of \$5,000 and up to faculty and staff members
 - Deadline this year is May 16

Grant Approval

- Support for Grant Writing
 - GCC does not have permanent staff available for grant writing assistance
 - GCC does have several grant writers working with us on an as-needed basis

Coordination & Information

- Coordination of grant applications and contacts can be difficult
- Private foundations often accept only one application or letter from an institution – sending more than one doesn't look good
- Grants web page to help coordinate information: list of funders contacted to prevent conflicts
- * A "grants process group" has been meeting to provide feedback on the grants process and grant applications

Approval Process

- "Grant Summary Sheet" to provide information about grant, including the college's commitments
- Approval by Vice President
