

SLOs for NS 214

- SLO #1. Students will learn to adequately integrate level-four medical-surgical knowledge, including leadership, Renal, Immunodeficiency, Burns, Respiratory, Cardiac, Neurologic, and Hepato biliary Disorders, in order to provide appropriate nursing care for acutely ill patients
- SLO #2. Students will learn to provide safe patient care through knowledge and application of accurate medication dosaging, for acutely ill, as well as critically ill patients
- SLO #3. Students will learn to develop leadership and management skills while integrating professional values, ethics and standards into a personal philosophy of nursing practice.

SLOs for NS 215

- SLO # 1. The student will be able to present ideas and research in organized and engaging poster presentations and oral arguments relevant to important nursing issues. This includes the ability to use graphs, diagrams, and algorithms which are well organized and developed; conform to time constraints; make stylistic choices in persona, syntax, and diction; gauge the needs of and addresses a specific contemporary nursing issue; show evidence of ability to evaluate and incorporate sources for reliability, credibility, and authority relative to a given nursing topic.
- SLO # 2. The student will be able assess the current literature using relevant databases, critique the literature for content and apply the information to their practice of nursing.

SLOs for NS 204

- SLO # 1. Students enrolled in Nursing 204 seminar will apply the cumulative knowledge of the nursing process, pharmacology, and pathophysiology to case studies and computerized manikin scenarios.
