- SLO #1. At the end of this 6 week course, the student will be able to use library databases, APA format and evidence-based articles to formulate a group presentation on a specific health topic.
 - Assessment Methods: Group presentations using library databases for research and presentation.
- SLO #2. At the end of this 6 week course, the student will be able to define healthcare terms and understand historical and current nursing practice issues within the healthcare delivery system.
 - Assessment Method: Overall course grade of 75% or better
- SLO #3. At the end of this 6 week course, the student will be able to define and cite examples of the principles of Quality Safety Education for Nurses (QSEN).
 - Assessment Method: Quiz # 1 and Exam # 1 scores of 75% of better

SLO for NS 205

- SLO #1. At the end of this 6 week course, the student will analyze simple medication orders for all types of medication administration and compute the correct dosage.
 - Assessment Method: Dosage Calculation Exam with score of 90% or better.
