

SLOs for NS 200

SLO #1. *At the end of this 6 week course, the student will be able to use library databases, APA format and evidence-based articles to formulate a group presentation on a specific health topic.*

Assessment Methods: Group presentations using library databases for research and presentation.

SLO #2. *At the end of this 6 week course, the student will be able to define healthcare terms and understand historical and current nursing practice issues within the healthcare delivery system.*

Assessment Method: Overall course grade of 75% or better

SLO #3. *At the end of this 6 week course, the student will be able to define and cite examples of the principles of Quality Safety Education for Nurses (QSEN).*

Assessment Method: Quiz # 1 and Exam # 1 scores of 75% or better

SLO for NS 205

SLO #1. *At the end of this 6 week course, the student will analyze simple medication orders for all types of medication administration and compute the correct dosage.*

Assessment Method: Dosage Calculation Exam with score of 90% or better.

SLO #2. *At the end of this 6 week course, the student will be able to demonstrate comprehension of basic principles of pharmacodynamics, pharmacokinetics and medication administration using the nursing process.*

Assessment Method: Cumulative course score of 75% or above on the NCLEX-RN style questions on the quizzes, midterm and final comprehensive exam.
