UPDATE

Attached is a summary report on Measure G Fund activity and budget balances through August 31, 2012.

The report reflects the re-allocation agreed upon by the Board of Trustees and will be updated and presented at each Board meeting.

The project schedule update is enclosed and has been updated with the current status or proposed status of the projects.

Project Schedule Update:

Technology

Consultants have been engaged to assist with the programming of miscellaneous high priority
PeopleSoft projects. These projects include: verification and updating of students' educational
goals; the PeopleSoft interface with e-transcript; blocking repeats within mandated parameters;
and development of repeatability parameters for classes where repeats are allowed. The
consultants are also providing knowledge transfer as part of this engagement.

Lab/College Services Project

- The State has appropriated allocated the funding for the construction of the project.
- The bidding process is estimated to commence in early 2013.

Server Room Upgrade Project

- Plans and designs have been submitted to the Division of State Architect for approval.
- An energy audit has been completed and the resolution to approve the project under the Energy Conservation provisions of the Government Code is pending at the September 10, 2012 board meeting.
- Purchase and award of the contracts for long lead time equipment is pending approval at the September 10, 2012 board meeting.
