Several versions of a level 4/5 writing rubric had been used, yet instructors continued to struggle with its measuring quality. At this meeting on 8/28/12, the instructors agreed on a final version of a new rubric to implement in the measuring of level 4 and 5 students.

FINDINGS: Instructors have been struggling with the point system and categories of the division's level 4 and 5 rubrics.

PLANS: A new and improved version was proposed and approved for implementation

starting Fall 2012.
