Deadlines and Decisions

- Spring 2013 Admission
 - Priority Deadline October 15, 2012
 - Evaluation of applications will begin in October
- Fall 2013 Admission
 - Early Priority Deadline February 1, 2013
 - Guaranteed decision March 15th
 - Course evaluation by April 1st
 - Priority Deadline March 15, 2013
 - Guaranteed decision May 1st
 - Course evaluation by June 1st
 - Evaluation of applications will begin in January

Completed Application

Required "documents"

- Common Application (including LMU Supplement)
 - http://admission.lmu.edu/apply.htm
 - www.commonapp.org
- Official transcripts from ALL colleges attended
 - If a student has completed fewer than 30 transferable semester units, high school transcript & ACT/SAT scores must also be submitted

Supplemental Application Documents

- Letters of Recommendation
 - does not have to come from counselor

 - May allow us to make a decision without waiting for final transcripts

Eligibility for Admission

- *General* Requirements
 - Full-time Student (12+ units/semester)
 - 3.00 Grade Point Average and 30 transferable semester units
 - generally necessary for eligibility for most majors
 - neither a minimum or a guarantee for admission

Fall 2012 = 2000 applications / 350 spaces / 700 admits

Average GPA = 3.40

Specifics / Impacted Programs

- Business Administration
 - Business Calculus (minimum "B" grade) with coursework in Accounting/Business Law/Computer Information Systems/Economics/Statistics
- Communication and Fine Arts
 - Communication Studies (usually B+ average necessary since it is a competitive major)
 - Recommended courses in CMST, SPCH plus a solid understanding of major objectives/goals

Specifics / Impacted Programs

Film and TV

 Animation, Production (the most impacted major at LMU) and Recording Arts have limited openings and available space will vary from semester to semester. Successful transfer candidates usually have freshman or sophomore standing.

Liberal Arts

- Economics (minimum "B-" grades in Math Analysis/Business Calculus)
- Psychology (coursework is expected in Human Anatomy and Physiology, Introduction to Psychology, and Statistics)
- Science and Engineering
 - Math and Science grades in Biology, Chemistry, Physics and Calculus for Life Sciences/Calculus

University Core Curriculum & Transfer of Units

- Maximum 60 units can transfer from community college coursework
- Core Curriculum Requirements
 - American Cultures
 - College Writing
 - Communication or Critical Thinking
 - Critical and Creative Arts
 - History
 - Literature
 - Math, Science and Technology
 - Philosophy
 - Social Sciences
 - Theological Studies
