Measures for "Institution-Set Standards" for ACCJC Annual Report

Due March 31, 2013, the ACCJC Annual Report must include "institution-set standards" for five measures. Standards appear to be minimum standards that define the minimum level of educational quality and institutional effectiveness.

from ACCJC Annual Report instructions:

A "standard" is the level of performance set by the institution to meet educational quality and institutional effectiveness expectations. This number may differ from a performance improvement "goal" which an institution may aspire to meet.
