The purpose of this agreement is to establish and maintain an articulated program to facilitate the transfer of students from Glendale Community College to Charles R. Drew University of Medicine and Science, baccalaureate program in Life Sciences.

In accordance with the University's Transfer Credit Policy, a maximum of 63 semester units can be transferred from a regionally accredited institution toward a CDU bachelor degree. The maximum transfer credit acceptable for the associate degree is up to 50% of the total units required for the program. Only courses with a "C" or better are transferable to undergraduate degree programs.

This agreement shall be subject to annual review by representatives from the receiving and sending institutions. Changes or revisions shall be made during the annual review. This agreement may be terminated by either party via written notice of at least one full semester prior to the desired termination date.
