Music 161 Piano II

I. Catalog Statement

Music 161 advances the beginning pianist's fundamental skills. Emphasis will be given to beginning concepts of interpretation and tone coloring,

Units – 2.0 Lecture Hours – 2.0

Prerequisite: Music 160 or equivalent.

Note: This course may be taken a maximum of two times for a total of four units.

II. Course Entry Expectations

Skills Level Ranges: Reading 4; Writing 3; Listening/Speaking 4+; Math 2

Prior to enrolling in the course, the student should be able to:

- 1. apply the basic techniques of piano playing in beginning piano repertoire;
- 2. model basic posture for playing piano;
- 3. play all white-key major scales and primary chords, hands separately;
- 4. perform beginning piano literature, both hands together at a level of "Theme from Mozart's Sonata in A", arranged by Bastien.

III. Course Exit Standards

Upon successful completion of the required coursework, the student will be able to:

- 1. apply the basic techniques of piano playing in early-intermediate piano repertoire;
- 2. model basic posture for playing piano;
- 3. play all white-key major scales, primary chords, and inversions, hands together;
- 4. perform early-intermediate piano literature at a level of "Bagatelle" by Diabelli.

A. Major Scales in two octaves, primary chords, and inversions, hands together (C, G, D, A, E, F, B)	10 hours
B. Performance repertoire	24 hours
F. Sight reading	8 hours
G. Technical exercises	6 hours
