PROBATION, DISMISSAL, AND READMISSION

Probation

A student shall be placed on academic probation if the student has earned a cumulative grade point average below 2.0.

A student shall be placed on progress probation if the student has enrolled in a total of at least twelve (12) semester units and the percentage of all units in which the student has enrolled, for which entries of "W," "I" "NC" and "NP" were recorded reaches or exceeds fifty percent.

A student shall be removed from academic probation when the student's cumulative grade point average reaches or exceeds 2.0. A student shall be removed from progress probation when the percentage of units of "W" "I" and "NP(NC)" drops below fifty percent.

Dismissal

A student who is on academic probation shall be subject to dismissal if the student has earned a cumulative grade point average below 2.0 in all units attempted in each of three consecutive semesters.

A student who is on progress probation shall be subject to dismissal if the percentage of cumulative units in which the student has enrolled for which entries of "W" "I" and "NP (NC)" are recorded in three consecutive semesters reaches or exceeds fifty percent.

Readmission

A student who has been dismissed may return to the College after "sitting out" one semester, or based on documented extenuating circumstances may submit an appeal for readmission. The appeal process is contained in Administrative Regulation 4255.
