Board Policy

COMMITTEES OF THE BOARD

The Board of Trustees (Board) may by action establish committees that it determines are necessary to assist the Board in its responsibilities. Board committees shall be assigned to reinforce the wholeness of the Board's job and not to interfere with delegation from Board to the Superintendent/President, in the operation of the college, or in governance matters. Any committee established by Board action shall comply with the requirements of the Brown Act and with these policies regarding open meetings.

Standing and ad hoc committees to assist the Board in its role as policy makers may be limited and/or created as deemed necessary by a majority of the Board or at the request of the Superintendent/President.

Any Board-appointed committee serves in an advisory capacity to the Board and shall avoid making any commitments which might be interpreted as binding contracts or commitments on the part of the District.

Board committees have no authority or power to act on behalf of the Board. Findings or recommendations from the committees of the Board shall be reported to the Board for consideration.

Board committees that are composed solely of less than a quorum of members of the Board are not required to comply with the Brown Act, or with the policies regarding open meetings, unless they are designated a Board standing committee.
