**EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN**

The District is committed to protecting the safety and security of those associated with the District should an emergency situation occur. To that end, the District will maintain an Emergency Operations Plan in order to help:

Protect life and safety;

Reduce property and environmental damage;

Minimize disruption and economic losses; and

Shorten the post-event recovery period.

The Superintendent/President, or his/her designee, shall establish an administrative regulation to ensure that the District implements a plan to be activated in the event of an emergency, a natural disaster or hazardous condition.

All District personnel must be informed that as public employees, they are also disaster service workers during national, state, and local emergencies.
