Board Policy

Determination Of Residence

Students shall be classified at the time of each application for admission as a resident or nonresident student.

A resident is any person who has been a bona fide resident of California for at least one year and has established legal residence within California by the residence determination date. The residence determination date shall be the day immediately preceding the first day of a semester or an inter-session for which the student applies to attend.

A student previously classified as a nonresident may be reclassified prior to registration of any semester or inter-session once the one year residence has been established.

The Superintendent/President or designee shall enact procedures to assure that residence determinations are made in accordance with Education Code and Title 5 regulations.
