BOARD EDUCATION

The Board of Trustees is committed to an ongoing training program for board development.

The program will include two special meeting retreats annually, reading materials on trusteeship provided by the Superintendent/President and governing board organizations to which the college belongs, support for participation in the Community College League of California Excellence in Trusteeship program, and attendance at state, regional, and national conferences focused on education policy and education governance. The expected benefit of attendance at conferences should be commensurate with the expense and contribute to the Board Member's continued development.

Newly appointed or elected members of the Board shall be provided orientation to include: an overview of board roles and responsibilities, board focus areas, communications protocols, and college district overview; welcome packet (minutes from recent board meetings, college reports and accountability data, meeting calendar, district budget, board policies); support for attendance at the Community College League of California new trustee workshop; and access to resources to familiarize the new trustee with roles and responsibilities (www.trustee-education.org and www.ccleague.org).
