BOARD OF TRUSTEES EVALUATION

The Board of Trustees is committed to assessing its performance as a Board in order to identify its strengths and areas in which it may improve its functioning to assure academic quality, integrity, and effectiveness of the student learning programs and services and the financial stability of the college.

To that end, the Board annually will engage in an evaluation process that addresses criteria contained in these board policies regarding board operations, criteria defining board effectiveness promulgated by recognized practitioners in the field, and expectations defined in accreditation standards.

The process for evaluation shall be completed at the Special Board meeting in the spring/summer and a summary of the evaluations will be presented on the agenda and discussed at a board meeting.
