
◆DAY 1 ~ SALEM, EUGENE◆

Our journey to explore Oregon's coast and covered bridges begins at Los Angeles International Airport for a nonstop flight to Portland, Oregon. Upon our arrival a deluxe motorcoach will be waiting to transport us for the next eight days. Time for lunch at leisure in **Salem** before we continue south into the Willamette Valley. Later we arrive in **Eugene** to begin a two-night stay at a unique resort-style hotel (with river view rooms) located along the quiet banks of the **Willamette River**. An included **Welcome Dinner** at a local favorite this evening. (Dinner)



DAY 2 ~ COVERED BRIDGES

Following an included breakfast we set out with a **local guide** to explore the nostalgic and romantic covered bridges in **Cottage Grove**, the "Covered



Bridge Capital of Oregon." Oregon has the largest collection of covered bridges in the West and one of the largest in the nation. The coveredbridge-building tradition in Oregon dates from the 1850s when rugged pioneers armed with only hand tools, sweat and ambition began building covered bridges. With our guide we will visit some of the most picturesque and unique bridges in the area and get a look at a well-preserved past in the beautiful setting of the Pacific Northwest. Besides a spectacular coastline and lighthouses, Oregon is known for their wines. The Willamette Valley is often compared with the wine-producing region of Burgundy, France because of similar latitudinal, soil and climatic conditions. We'll enjoy an included lunch and wine tasting at an awardwinning winery. We return to the hotel with the balance of the day at leisure. (Breakfast, Lunch)



◆DAY 3 ~ EUGENE TO BANDON◆

Following an included breakfast we travel over the Coastal Range and arrive at the Oregon coast. A visit to an **elk viewing area** to view these majestic creatures. As we leisurely make our way along the scenic coast route we'll find magnificent panoramic views of the Pacific Ocean along with lighthouses, sheer cliffs, pristine beaches, pounding surf and the warm hospitality of the merchants and residents. Coos Bay to tour a myrtle wood factory, where you can see master craftsmen at work carving wooden items made from this native hardwood only found in Oregon and Israel. Later we arrive in **Bandon-by-the-Sea** and begin a two-night stay at a property within steps of the beach. (Breakfast)

◆DAY 4 ~ BANDON, ROGUE RIVER◆

An included breakfast this morning before we explore Bandon State Natural Area. You will be amazed by the scenery along the scenic Beach Loop with sights such as Bandon Rocks and Face Rock, known to many from the American Indian legend. Anticipation mounts as we travel south to Gold Beach for a thrilling ride aboard a high-speed jet boat through one of Oregon's great natural treasures, the scenic Rogue River. This Congress-designated National Wild and Scenic River tumbles and roars from high in the Cascade Range to the shores of the Pacific and is home to tons of native wildlife. Your river boat guide will point out any black bear, river otter, black-tail deer, bald eagles, great blue heron and Canada geese, all commonly seen along the river! You will be following in the footsteps of history along the 'Historic Mail Boat Route' just as Rogue River pioneers have done since 1895 when mail and freight were prized commodities and road access did not exist. We will disembark from the boat for an included family-style lunch at a river-front lodge. We return to Bandon with the balance of the evening at leisure. (Breakfast, Lunch)

*DAY 5 ~ DUNES, LIGHTHOUSE *

After an included breakfast this morning we travel north along the coast and arrive at the Oregon Dunes National Recreation Area, a natural wonder of endless shifting sand, unique tree islands and lots of interesting creatures. Here you'll board a four-wheel drive vehicle driven by an experienced guide for an exhilarating ride up and down these expansive tracts of sand that are almost 300 feet high. Following lunch on own in Florence, we continue north to the 19th century Haceta Head Lighthouse, listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Built in 1894, the light emitted is the most powerful on the Oregon Coast, signaling ships up to 21 miles out to sea. Later we arrive in Newport for a two-night stay at a hotel located high on a bluff overlooking the pristine beach and Pacific Ocean below. Every room has an ocean view with a private balcony and fireplace. We'll enjoy an included dinner at a local favorite. (Breakfast, Dinner)

DAY 6 ~ NEWPORT

This morning, following an included breakfast we visit the **Oregon Coast Aquarium** where we can immerse ourselves in the mysteries of the ocean. This Aquarium is a world-class marine educational attraction nestled on 4½-acres on beautiful **Yaquina Bay**. Come face to face with

the creatures living in offshore and near-shore Pacific marine habitats: frolicking sea otters, colorful puffins, pulsating jellyfish, and even a 60-pound octopus. Walk through a 200-foot underwater tunnel with 360-degree views of sharks, wolf eels, halibut, and a truly captivating array of sea life. Later we embark on a narrated sea life cruise with an onboard naturalist guide to look for marine mammals and birds in their natural environment. Aboard the deluxe 65-foot *Discovery* we'll enjoy the incredible scenery of Yaquina Bay featuring the largest fishing fleet on the Oregon coast. Enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure relaxing at the hotel or walking on the beach. (Breakfast)

DAY 7 ~ TILLAMOOK, CANNON BEACH

Following an included breakfast we visit the Yaquina Head Lighthouse, Oregon's tallest lighthouse. We continue north following US-101 and the spectacular Oregon coast. Later we arrive in Tillamook, a city synonymous with the dairy industry. We'll see the factory and you'll have a bird's-eye view of the cheese making and packaging teams in action, churning out 167,000 pounds of Tillamook Cheese each and every day - and they have samples too! We continue on making a brief stop in Rockaway Beach to see Twin Rocks. Later we arrive in Cannon Beach, home to Haystack Rock, the famous landmark towering 235 feet above sea level. This is the third largest coastal monolith in the world and its closeness to the beach will astound you. Our quaint inn is only one block from the beach. An included Farewell Dinner this evening at a local favorite in the artsy village of Cannon Beach. (Breakfast, Dinner)

•DAY 8 ~ JOURNEY HOME •

Following an included breakfast this morning we travel north to the historic city of **Astoria**, the oldest American settlement west of the Rockies. We'll visit **Fort Clatsop National Memorial**, the winter headquarters of the Lewis and Clark expedition and the first U.S. military post west of St. Louis. Enjoy time for lunch at leisure in historic downtown Astoria. We continue eastward following the **Columbia River** to the Portland Airport for our non-stop return flight to Los Angeles. We return home with images of Oregon's coast, lighthouses, covered bridges, and so much more forever ingrained in our memories. (Breakfast)
