


Each of the House in Shenzhen is designed as a unique luxury hillside residence, with the approach to program varying for each house while maintaining a common design approach. The house range in size from 600 to 1,000 square meters, and their overall height and number of floor is dictated by the siting of each house. The project brief required the creation of unique residential neighborhood that maintains formal balance with its mountain environment, and the siting and design of each house maximizes privacy and view while minimizing impact to the site.

The site is characterized by steep rolling landscape of mountains and valleys, and all five houses are situated on a steep hillside and oriented along an east-west axis, which maximizes views to the south while maintaining east-west exposure. All five houses are approached from the north, where the garage and driveway are located through each house leads from an opaque northern facade to a glazed southern facade, where terraces and a pool are oriented to offer optimal exposure to the sun and views to the bay below.

A large double-height living room, situated to offer the best views to the south and east, functions as the centerpiece for each house. The dining spaces and kitchen are located adjacent to the living room to complete the public core. The bedrooms are located on one or two higher floors and separated from the public spaces to allow privacy, with the master bedroom enjoying the most privacy and best views. A family room is typically located adjacent to the bedrooms, providing an intimate living space. The lower floors and basement house recreation rooms and service space. Exterior spaces are integrated with the building structure as balconies and terraces along the southern facades, with overhangs and canopies protecting the outdoor spaces from sun and rain and allowing year-round use.





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




TETRIS



The name Tetris comes from the Greek word tetra or "four". Tetris is a computer puzzle game in which various shapes each made of four squares are falling down a well. The user turns the pieces around and moves them left or right in order to arrange them on top of the other. When a solid line of squares is made from edge to edge, the line dissolves and all the pieces move down by one square. When the lines dissolve points are won, when the well fills up the game ends. Players work hard to keep the well as empty as possible, but as the game progresses the pieces fall faster and faster making that harder.






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


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Greek Theater

Structure of the Greek Theater

Ancient Greek theaters were **very large, open-air structures** that took advantage of sloping hillsides for their terraced seating. Because of drama's close connection with religion, theaters were often located in or near sanctuaries. The core of any Greek theater is the **orchestra**, the "dancing place" of the chorus and the chief **performance space**. The audience sat in the **theatron**, the "seating place," in semi-circular terraced rows of benches (in the earliest theaters these were wooden; they were later built of stone). The Greeks often built these in a natural hollow (a *kollen*), though the sides were increasingly reinforced with stone, as can be seen in this overhead view of Epidaurus. Scholars often use the Latin word for hollow, *cavea*, to designate the seating in an ancient theater. Stairs mounting to the highest levels divide the sections of seats into wedges; at Epidaurus there are 55 **semi-circular rows**, providing an estimated seating capacity of 12,000-14,000.


The Greek theater history began with festivals honoring their gods. A god, Dionysos, was honored with a festival called by "City Dionysia". In Athens, during this festival, men used to perform songs to honor Dionysos. Plays were added to the City Dionysia festival. Athens was the center for these theatrical traditions. Athens opened these festivals to the numerous cities in order to promote a common identity. At the early Greek festivals, the actors, director, and dramatists were all the same person. After some time, only three actors were allowed to perform in each play. Later few non-speaking roles were allowed to perform onstage. Only a limited number of actors allowed on-stage, the chorus involved into a very active part of Greek theater. Music was often played during the choral delivery of its lines. Panoramic view of the Greek theater at Epidaurus. Tragedy, Comedy, and tragic plays were the theatrical forms. Tragedy and comedy were viewed as contrasting experiences. Tragedy dealt with the psychological subject to cosmic measure. Aristotle's *Poetics* sets out a thesis about the perfect structure for tragedy.

Fit into each other as parts of machinery, so that all action is synchronized. A connection that the individual parts affect each other in motion or operation. An arrangement of signal apparatus that prevents conflicting movements through an arrangement of tracks such as junctions or crossings.




Mortise and Tenon:

A joint has been used for thousands of years by woodworkers around the world to join pieces of wood, mainly when the adjoining pieces connect at an angle of 90°. In its basic form it is both simple and strong. Although there are many joint variations, the basic mortise and tenon comprises two components: the mortise hole and the tenon. The tenon, formed on the end of a member generally referred to as a rail, is inserted into a square or rectangular hole cut into the corresponding member. The tenon is cut to fit the mortise hole exactly and usually has shoulders that seat when the joint fully enters the mortise hole. The joint may be glued, pinned, or wedged to lock it in place.



Design Development Steps:

1. Cut 45 degree angle each corner North & South.
2. Mirrored shape to next level.
3. Stack up shape to level ten.
4. Created two solid shape.



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
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5. Cutting away volumes system to control placement and creating exterior and interior spaces. There for arrangement system of prevents conflicting movements and tracks such as junctions or crossings and overlapping of volumes space interlock can share equally.

6. Using Interlocking system and Mortise and Tenon Method to joint two shape.

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
