**Time to Completion of Associate Degree**

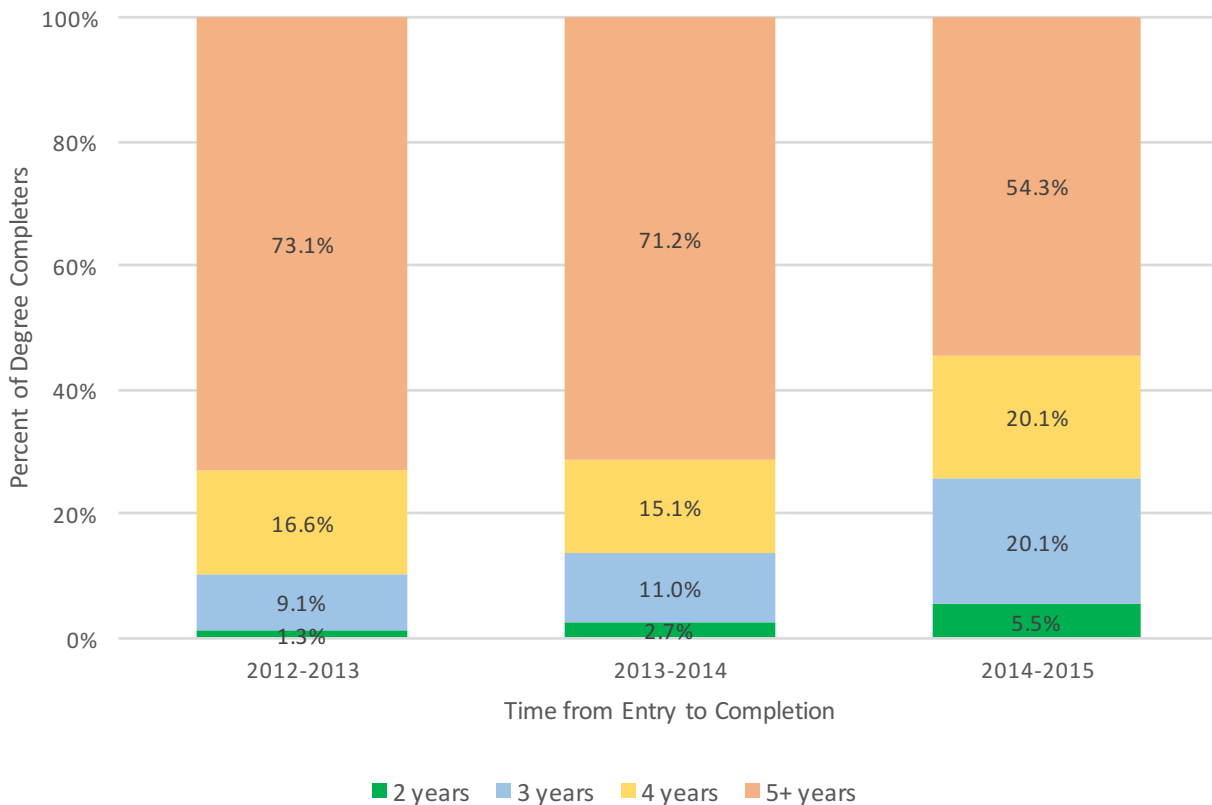
The table shows the number of years students take to complete associate degrees. For example, a student completing a degree in Spring 2015 who started at GCC during Fall 2013 is counted as completing the degree in two years. A student completing a degree in Spring 2015 who started at GCC during Fall 2012 is counted as completing the degree in three years.

Note: The numbers of degree completers reported here are lower than other sources such as the Campus Profile because only students completing 60 or more units at GCC are included here, in order to exclude students completing requirements at other colleges.
