Complete these steps by April 24 to receive priority registration for Fall 2020.

STEP 1 — APPLICATION

- Complete your Application for Admission for the Fall 2020 semester
 - Visit www.glendale.edu/application

STEP 2 — PLACEMENT

- Placement into English and Math classes no longer requires a test. Visit the Assessment Center (SV 3rd Floor) with the following items:
 - Know your high school GPA and the grade in your last English and Math classes.
 - If you do not have high school records or are a returning student, visit the Assessment Center for guidance.
