9. Process for Deciding When New Programs Require Substantive Change Proposals to the Accrediting Commission

New programs that represent a significant departure from existing programs, or can be completed at least 50% off-site or online, require substantive change proposals to the accrediting commission. The college should have a process to decide when such proposals are required.
