

This 27-day program explores the music, culture, religion and geography of Bali, Indonesia. Dr. Wendy Fonarow highlights Bali's mysterious blending of magic, ancestor worship and Hinduism through lectures, readings, visits to religious sites, and observations of Balinese religious ceremonies. Prof. Paul Sherman leads our exploration of Bali's unique musical traditions through lectures, discussions, observing and playing Balinese musical instruments. Prof. Darren Leaver guides our field-based Geography course through activities that include volcano hikes, rice field treks, snorkel adventures, and Balinese cultural performances. The program ends with a 4-day/3-night exploration of Sydney, Australia. Students must enroll in at least 2 courses.

Program Locations: Ubud (14 ni), Pemuteran (2 ni), Candidasa (6 ni), Sydney (3 ni).

Program Includes: 25 nights accommodation based on triple and double occupancy in villas and tourist-class hotels with air conditioning and swimming pools. Daily breakfast and 12 additional meals. Transfers and transportation as part of the program itinerary. Entry to cultural sites and temples including Elephant Cave, Monkey Forest, Gunung Kawi, and more. Activities including downhill bike ride, volcano and waterfall treks, Treetops course, snorkeling at Manjangan Island and Amed, Gamelan orchestra, Kecak and Legong dance performances.

Not Included: Airfare of approximately \$1,500, GCC tuition & fees, textbooks, beverages, meals & activities not part of the itinerary, tips to local staff (\$50), spending money (\$500+).
