Assessment Method	Describe how the SLO/PLO was assessed.  Students in every APE class were given a pre and posttest (anonymously) for Fall 2013, Spring 2014, Fall 2014 and Spring 2015. Pre and posttests for each class were tallied. Those tallies were included in a composite tally of pretests and posttests for each semester. Simple percentages were established comparing pre and posttest for each semester and the data was graphed for comparison. Information for Fall 2012 and Spring 2013 was amassed on old Moodle format and was lost when college moved to a new Moodle format. Therefore only 2 years of data was available to be evaluated.
