**CRIME BULLETIN: Aggravated Assault Off- Campus** 

**DATE: 05-25-17** 

The following crime bulletin is being released for informational purposes to keep the campus community better informed of crimes near campus and to take appropriate precautions for their safety.

**Synopsis**: On Tuesday, May 23 at around 12:30 a.m. an aggravated assault stabbing occurred across the street from the Glendale Community College Garfield Campus. This incident occurred after the Garfield Campus was closed and in the Family Medicine Center parking lot located at 801 S. Chevy Chase Dr. A male victim was hanging out with a friend when a group of unknown males approached them and attacked the victim.

There is no information or indication to believe any members of the campus community were specifically targeted. It is also unknown if this incident is related to a previous aggravated assault that occurred at this location on February, 22, 2017. The City of Glendale Police Department is investigating the case; see contact information at the bottom.
