
Understanding NAICS

The North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) is the standard used by Federal statistical agencies in classifying business establishments for the purpose of:

- ✓ Collecting
- ✓ Analyzing
- ✓ publishing statistical data related to U.S. business economy

NAICS industry codes define establishments based on the activities in which they are primarily engaged.


Top 10 Industries in LA County

Minimum Wage & Living Wage

- CA minimum wage in 2017: \$10.50
- LA County living wage
 - **1** Adult: \$13.08
 - 1 Adult 1 Child: \$27.66

- It's possible that more job postings exists since BG only relies on online job postings




Education Requirements in LA County 2016






