



How to Move Your Moodle Course Materials Into Your GCC Canvas Courses

THE MOTHER OF ALL CANVAS TIPS: Don't use Internet Explorer!

Canvas and IE do NOT play well together — you will lose functionality (and if you are like me, you'll assume you are doing something wrong...)!! Most of the experts say that Google Chrome works best, but I have been using Firefox exclusively, and have not run into any problems.

(I haven't used Safari heavily on my Mac, but I do know that Canvas behaves well within my iPad browser.)

LATE BREAKING NEWS... a helpful faculty member and Mac user reports that she has been using Safari pretty much exclusively and has not encountered any problems.

This is from experienced Faculty using Canvas! Chrome browser is recommended.

First, A Quick Review on How to Back Up Your Moodle Course Materials:


To create a Moodle .mbz backup file to upload into Canvas (see next page)...


- In your course, click the "Backup" text.
- Click the "Jump to final step" button




Click on the Canvas icon.





Log in with your email login information.






Your course shells will appear here. Click on your course title to enter the course shell.








Now, click on the "Import Content Into This Course " option.




When the "Import Content" window comes up, click on the "Content Type" drop down and choose "Moodle 1.9/2.x".









Choose the file and click on "Open".




You will see the course title next to the browse button. Now, click on the red "import" button.




The Moodle course .mbz file will begin to load. It will say it is "queued" for upload. Larger courses may take a while!




Once it has loaded you may see an issues link. Click on that for info on the issues.




These type of issues are harmless and reflect Moodle only features that could not transfer.




Click on "Home" to see your populated course.




You can now put your finishing touches on the course content. Don't forget to publish it when you are ready for your students to see it.




You can contact this number after 7pm weekdays and all day weekends for support: (844) 871-3927. If you want to fill out a support ticket, click on "Report a Problem".
