General Studies Transfer Equivalents AND Articulation Agreement 2009-2010

To transfer to the Graziadio School of Business and Management's Bachelor of Science in Management program, a student must have earned an acceptable grade point average on 68 or more transferable semester units from a regionally accredited college or university. Students should be employed on a full-time basis or have significant prior work experience in order to relate to the other students and the material covered in the course. Final decision of transferable courses will be made by admission representatives at the Graziadio School of Business and Management, Pepperdine University.

AREA 1: ENGLISH COMPOSITION

(At least 1 course = 3 semester units must be completed with a grade of "C" or better prior to application for admission to the BSM Program)

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AREA 2: MATHEMATICS

(At least 1 course = 3 semester units must be completed with a grade of "C" or better prior to application for admission to the BSM Program)

MATHEMATICS	101, 100, 102, 103, 104, 105, 110, 112, 136
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AREA 3: ARTS AND HUMANITIES

(At least 3 courses = 9 semester units from Area 3)

All courses listed in the Glendale Graduation Requirements under Area 10c: Humanities **OR** Area C: Art, Literature, Philosophy and Foreign Language for CSU GE requirements **OR** Area 3: Arts and Humanities for IGETC **PLUS** the additional courses identified below:

AREA 4: SOCIAL AND BEHAVIORAL SCIENCE

(At least 4 courses = 12 semester units;
one course for 3 semester units **must** be in US History or American Government)

The following courses meet the U.S. History or American Government requirement:

The additional nine units (3 courses) for this area may be taken from courses listed above, **OR** all courses listed in the Glendale Graduation Requirements under Area 10b: Social Sciences **OR** Area D: Social, Political and Economic Institutions and Behavior for CSU GE requirements **OR** Area 4: Social and Behavioral Sciences for IGETC **PLUS** the additional courses identified below:

AREA 5: PHYSICAL AND BIOLOGICAL SCIENCES

(At least 1 course = 3 semester units)

All courses listed in the Glendale Graduation Requirements under Area 10a: Natural Science **OR** Area B1: Biological Science or B2: Physical Science for CSU GE requirements **OR** Area 5: Physical and Biological Sciences for IGETC.

AREA 6: LIFELONG LEARNING AND PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Additional 15 GE units to satisfy the minimum 45 units GE requirement may be drawn from any of the above subject areas PLUS those courses listed under:

Area B3: Mathematics **and** Area E: Life-Long Understanding and Self-Development (four-unit limit on activity courses) for CSU GE requirements **OR**

Area 2: Mathematical Concepts and Quantitative Reasoning for IGETC

PLUS the additional courses identified below:

AREA 7: ELECTIVES

An additional 23-35 semester units of course work from Areas 1 to 6 above PLUS AA/AS major preparation courses. Other courses not listed above that are applicable to the AA degree may be reviewed for applicability as electives. Students are encouraged to take courses from the following areas to enhance their preparation for the Graziadio School's BSM program: **ACCOUNTING; BANKING AND FINANCE; BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION; BUSINESS INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY; HOSPITALITY; MARKETING.**

In addition, the following courses have been articulated so as to provide an option for students to *WAIVE UP TO 12 UNITS OF BSM COURSE WORK, thus reducing the residential units to be taken at Pepperdine to 48 units. A minimum of four additional elective units are required for each four-unit courses waived.*

- Grade B or better in ACCTG 101 (5) and ACCTG 102 (5) to waive BSM 472 Accounting (4). Students may take ACCTG 105 and ACCTG 106 with B or better grades in lieu of ACCTG 101.
- Grade B or better in ECON 101 (3) and ECON 102 (3) to waive BSM 469 Managerial Economics (4)

Note that students who waive any of the above courses in the BSM program, and who subsequently enroll in the MBAJ program will be required to complete the equivalent MBA core course.
