




## Canvas Course Design – Hiding and Showing Courses and Course Sections




Has your Dashboard become a bit cluttered with course cards? Here is how to hide and unhide them in your Dashboard view.




Click on "Courses" in the red vertical menu bar, and then click on "all courses".




To hide a course card in your dashboard, click on the little star so that the color is gone. To show a course card, click on the little star so that some color is showing in it.




Now, only the course cards you currently want to see will show in your course Dashboard page.




Are your course navigation menus (white vertical menu) becoming a bit cluttered as well? Also is your "Files" section visible to students?




Choose the "Settings" section at the bottom of the white menu.






Drag the sections (like your Files section) that you want to hide from your students into the lower section on this page.



To get an idea of what students will see when you are done, click on "Student View" in the right hand side menu on the "Settings" page.



Now your course menu will be show only what your students need to see. To leave student view, click on the "Leave Student View" button in the bright pink bar at the bottom of the page.
