Assessing every semester	<ul> <li>For some, assessing every three years seems too much for others not enough</li> <li>Everyone must meet the minimum three-year cycle</li> <li>We have a problem with courses being assessed but not all of the SLOs are being assessed</li> <li>There is still confusion in regard to exit standards being the same or confused with student learning outcomes</li> <li>Often people will have too many SLOs attached to a course description</li> <li>To change the number of SLOs attached to a course CNI needs only one reading</li> <li>Will the accreditation board remove SLOs?         <ul> <li>This was an opinion piece and not fact</li> <li>Assessment timelines are not consistent</li> <li>Perhaps the Board will give colleges more guidance</li> </ul> </li> <li>Ask at division meetings how they will feel about assessing every semester</li> </ul>
