PROGRAM REVIEW?

Program Review is a data-driven departmental self-evaluation. It occurs at every college and university for quality assurance.

Formerly completed only by managers and division chairs, all members of the department are now included and have an opportunity to give input. This should include staff and part time faculty.



Examine data that is meaningful to the department and remember the 3Ds:

DATA

STUDENT SERVICES & ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES DEPTS data on services & operations	INSTRUCTIONAL DEPTS enrollment - degree & cert completion course completion that compares gender, ethnicity, online vs hybrid vs face-to-face, & day vs eve
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DIALOG

Input from all department members should be valued. This includes staff and adjunct faculty.
Discuss your accomplishments & achievements. Address any weaknesses or equity gaps.
Make a plan for improvement.

DOCUMENTATION

Have someone document notes or minutes about the dialog. Submit documentation with your Program Review. All documentation will be archived.

Program Review allows for requests for personnel and non-personnel resources.
