To be eligible to teach fully Online or Hybrid courses, instructors must be both DE Certified and DE Instruction Eligible. Eligibility is maintained through the annual completion of **Glendale Annual Distance Education Recertification (GADER)**. For full-time faculty, 6 hours, and for part-time faculty, 3 hours are needed annually.

DE Eligibility lapses if the GADER requirement is not completed by March 15, 2019.

DE Community of Practice...How does it work?

The Distance Education **Community of Practice (CoP)** at GCC is organized within a Canvas course of the same name. All DE certified faculty have been added to the course. If you do not see the course or your dashboard, contact defacdev@glendale.edu to be added.

All Community of Practice (CoP) Modules have 3 Parts:

- I.** Read or Watch something in advance of meeting (in the Canvas course)
- II.** Discuss something in advance of meeting (in the Canvas course)
- III.** Meet face-to-face (in the Faculty Innovation Center, SV 105; participation by Zoom welcome)!

You will be awarded 3 hours of GADER for each Module. If you cannot come to the meeting, you can still be awarded 2 hours of GADER; however, you cannot be awarded GADER for attending the face-to-face meeting without doing the online meeting work in advance.
