

- GCC success rates for Hybrid courses are equal or higher than that of face-to-face and online classes at GCC.
- GCC success rates for online course are below that of face-to-face and hybrid courses, but equal to the statewide achievement gap of 6%.

2. Success Rate for Credit Online/Hybrid






 GCC success rates for DE courses (Online/Hybrid) have consistently been higher than that of the statewide average since Fall 2011.

Note: Hybrid and online classes are not distinguished in statewide data.






 GCC DE course offerings have increased and decreased over the years. The growth has been minimal since fall 2013, but increasing slowly.




 GCC DE course offerings are way below that of the statewide offerings in other Community Colleges in CA – we have room to grow!
