Administrative Regulation

SHOWER FACILITIES FOR HOMELESS STUDENTS

The district maintains shower facilities for student use on campus that may be used by any currently enrolled homeless student who has paid required enrollment fees and is in good standing with the district.

A homeless student is defined as a student who does not have a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence. This includes, but is not limited to, students who: are sharing the housing of other persons due to loss of housing, economic hardship, or a similar reason; are living in motels, hotels, trailer parks, or camping grounds due to lack of alternative accommodations; are living in emergency or transitional shelters; have a primary nighttime residence that is a public or private place not designated for or ordinarily used as a regular sleeping accommodation for human beings; or are living in cars, parks, public spaces, abandoned buildings, substandard housing, bus or train stations, or similar settings.

Shower facilities are available in the men's and women's locker rooms located in the Sierra Nevada Building (SN). The showers are open for use by homeless students Monday – Thursday from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., and Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. In the event that these times conflict with the hours of an intercollegiate athletic program, the district will post a modified schedule of available shower facility hours a minimum of one day prior to the intercollegiate athletics event.
