## Class Descriptions

### Inventor's Workshop

Enter this Maker Space and create inventions that can solve problems and make life easier for everyone. Students will be given a challenge each week to create something that has never been thought of. This class will stretch your child's imagination and enhance their creativity.

### Reading & Writing

Students will enhance their skills in reading and writing by exploring a variety of literary works and developing a repertoire of written language through original stories, myths, poetry, and other forms of creative expression. Skills taught will help set the stage for writing success with the Common Core State Standards (CCSS). CCSS in all grade levels.

### Math Masterminds

Students will tackle math puzzles, challenges, and learn how to solve a variety of math problems, while also learning about the life and times of some of the world's great mathematicians.
