OVERVIEW FOR THE EDUCATION PLANNING PROCESS

TO GRADUATE WITH AN AA DEGREE OR TRANSFER TO A CALIFORNIA PUBLIC UNIVERSITY (UC OR CSU):

You MUST have a MINIMUM of 60 transferable units or GCC degree-applicable units for the AA.

THE UNITS WILL CONSIST OF THREE CATEGORIES:

- 1. Major requirements—Follow the Major sheet Assist.org (*unit requirements vary by major)
- 2. General Education (GE) Courses—Follow the IGETC/CSU/AA sheet (approx. 35-40 units)
- 3. Electives as needed to meet the unit requirement

Minimum 60 transferable units for UC ICSU or 60 degree applicable units for AA

GCC CERTIFICATES: REQUIREMENTS VARY; SEE SPECIFIC SHEETS FOR REQUIREMENTS. *

OUT-OF-STATE AND PRIVATE UNIVERSITIES: THE PROCESS IS THE SAME, HOWEVER, THE NUMBER OF UNITS AND THE SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS VARY.*
