- ▶ High school students take college classes
- ▶ College classes are offered at the high school site
- ▶ Students receive college credit from GCC
- ▶ Students can receive high school credit (please check with your school district)
- ▶ GCC waives all fees for students
- ▶ Books and supplies are the responsibility of the student. With some classes, books may be provided by the K-12 District.

Application Steps

If you have any questions about the application, you can contact Student Outreach Services at 818-240-1000 Ext. 4767

Before you begin the application make sure you have:

- An email account
 - Your social security number or a valid TIN (Tax identification Number)
 - Your address and phone number
 - Your educational history, including where you graduated from high school and the last college you attended, and the years you last attended these institutions
 - Know your residency status
- >>If you have a permanent resident card, you will need to know your alien registration number, the issued date and expiration date.

High School Concurrent Enrollment permits high school students the opportunity to enroll in courses at Glendale Community College for educational enrichment to a limited number of eligible students as defined in the California Education Code, Section 48800 and 76002.

1. Students must have current admission application on file. <https://www.glendale.edu/apply>
2. Students must have completed the 8th grade or equivalent prior to the beginning of the semester or term they plan to participate in the program.
3. Students will only be permitted to enroll in classes approved by the High School principal or counselor.
4. Students are limited to a maximum of six (6) units in each spring or fall term, and three (3) units in each winter or summer intersession.
5. The High School Concurrent Enrollment Recommendation form must be signed by the counselor and embossed or stamped with the high school's official seal.
6. Home-schooled students must attach a current copy of their Department of Education Private School Affidavit form with confirmation number.
7. Students must meet any English, Math, and/or other course prerequisites.
8. Credit courses are college courses and will remain on the student's permanent Glendale Community College transcript.
9. Glendale Community College is not responsible for the supervision of minor students anywhere on campus. Parents may not attend class with students.
10. Students must adhere to all college policies on course requirements, attendance, dates and deadlines, and any other applicable policies and procedures including the Student Code of Conduct. <https://www.glendale.edu/students/student-policies/student-conduct-policy>
11. Students must act on their own behalf. Parents, legal guardians, relatives, or friends of Glendale Community College students are not permitted to enroll, drop, or add classes on behalf of the student.
12. Student records are protected under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA). Therefore, GCC will not discuss or release student information to anyone, including parents, without the student's signed written consent.
13. GCC waives the enrollment & student fees for eligible CA residents. A free parking permit is provided to students with a current driver's license. (*Non-Resident and Materials Fee may apply)
14. Select non-immigrant Visa students may not be eligible to enroll as High School Concurrent Enrollment students. F-2 visa students, with required documentation, may be admitted to the program.
15. **PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN'S CONSENT:** The student may be exposed to educational programs designed for a diverse population of adult learners, which may involve sensitive topics that might be considered controversial or offensive to some. Your signature on this form acknowledges your receipt of this information and stipulates your permission for your child to enroll in college level courses and participate in all required activities that may include field trips off campus.

FERPA

- ▶ FAMILY EDUCATIONAL RIGHTS AND PRIVACY ACT (FERPA) is a federal law that protects the privacy of personally identifiable information contained in a student's educational record.
- ▶ Communication in regards to class and grades CAN ONLY happen between the professor and the student.
- ▶ Students need to turn in their own forms to enroll in the class.
- ▶ Students can access their information (grades, schedule, etc.) through MyGCC, the student portal.
