DESIGN MOBILE VIEW

Can I design my web page for mobile?	Yes. Access this feature from the tree view tab.
How does my page look on mobile?	In Edit mode, you can preview desktop, tablet, mobile.

ACCESSIBLITY & BEST PRACTICES

NO: Avoid long content pages	TLDR
	Divide content into chunks. Keep it short. Use bullet
	list.
YES: Headings	Use header tags to emphasize importance in hierarchy
	order. H1, H2, H3, etc.
NO: Underlining on the web	Underlining text on a web page looks like a hyperlink.
	Use bold to emphasize.
YES: Links on your page.	Use readable name for your link; links can be
	understood taken alone.
YES: Helpful Images	Use sparingly. Do your images enhance your content?
