



# GP Workgroup Meeting Report

Workgroup: Standing Open Forum

## 1. Updates from Workgroups

- a. Navigate - Kevin Meza
  - i. Working through login glitches; some students are experiencing login issues
  - ii. One of the early functions we will launch (not yet available) is appointment scheduling. Student services are having discussions, starting with a pilot in Counseling, about logistics and workflow.
  - iii. Kevin also commented on realities “on the ground” of GP efforts at other campuses, based on discussions with colleagues at other CCCs. There is a balance between visible/tangible deliverables emerging from GP efforts and the more subtle shifts in institutional ideology. This included a conversation about equity efforts embedded in GP work: it should be “purposeful and positively disruptive.” This line of inquiry led to the idea of holding a summit for people in specific roles of GP at local colleges (e.g., equity guides).
- b. Metamajors & Mapping - Richard Cortes
  - i. Workgroup has been active this month with three meetings since the last Standing Open Forum
  - ii. Revisiting the definition of metamajors (i.e., which programs are categorized in which metamajor); shifting toward career pathways and redefining metamajor titles
  - iii. Working to integrate Ryan Bishop’s career pathways work (presented at October 2019 Standing Open Forum)
  - iv. Discussions are underway about the visual presentation of pathways
  - v. Some discussion ensued about the extent to which we could design metamajors in a way that is consistent with other CCCs, and the potential issues are compounded by the California Virtual Campus (CVC) of the Online Education Initiative (OEI); outlook on this is uncertain
  - vi. Next Metamajors & Mapping Workgroup meeting is tomorrow at 12:30 in SV230
- c. Onboarding - Meg Chil-Gevorkyan
  - i. Last meeting took place this morning

- ii. Redesign/update of the New Student Enrollment Guide is underway; the guide was an outgrowth of student requests and was originally developed by GCC's Outreach Services; folding it into the work of the Onboarding Workgroup has potential to focus a campuswide discussion about the steps students need to take during matriculation to GCC
  - iii. These steps and the language that describes them will be integrated into Navigate To-Dos
  - iv. Comment was raised that we have versions of onboarding steps posted on "Apply to GCC" pages are not consistent with the New Student Enrollment Guide (e.g., general population pages, international students pages). Onboarding Workgroup can work to improve the consistency
- d. Professional Development & Communications - Sandy Somo
  - i. Sandy and Tom are supporting the transition to the new/permanent Communications Lead for this Workgroup
  - ii. Nominations are being accepted until noon on December 2, 2019 - [Link to nomination form](#)
  - iii. The Workgroup is focused on how we communicate about GP and institutional improvement effort
  - iv. A survey is being developed to gather feedback for a GP professional development event
- e. Student Voice - Hoover Zariani
  - i. Workgroup is working on spring 2020 student town halls focused on GP; tentatively, the first part would be students responding to pre-defined questions (soliciting question ideas now, so please suggest ideas to Hoover), and the second part would be a more free-form conversation with students.
  - ii. Working on an idea to develop a sort of toolkit to engage students in reflective activities
  - iii. Working on concerted effort of Student Voice Workgroup members going into student spaces to have more conversations and gather perspective

  - i. Email was sent to GCC announcing the workgroup and soliciting
