- ^The guick and easy answer is that most adults will get \$1,200
- ^ For every child age 16 or under, the payment would be an additional \$500
- ^ The actual amount of your payment depends on your income
- $^{\smallfrown}$ Single adults who have an adjusted gross income of \$75K or less will receive the full \$1200
- ^Married couples with no children, who earn \$150K or less will receive \$2400.
- ^If you file as head of household, you will get the full amount if you earn \$112,500 or less
- ^If you make above these income levels, the payments start to decrease. If you are single and earn \$99K or married earning \$198K, you will phase out and not receive a check.
- ^ Most people should receive their check within three weeks.

STUDENT LOANS

Just last week the Department of Education announced they would allow federal student loan borrowers to suspend payments without penalty and interest for 60 days. The coronavirus stimulus bill would increase this assistance and provide a sixmonth postponement period until Sept. 30, 2020. This again will be without penalty or interest accruing.

FOR RENTERS

120 day ban on evictions for renters and prohibits fees or penalties to those renters who fail to pay.
