Your application is scored based on three criteria. If there is information missing from your application and it is not explained, you will lose points, which means you may receive a smaller scholarship or NO scholarship.

The three criteria are:
Academic Success (40%)
Level of Service/Volunteering (40%)
Extenuating Circumstances (20%)

Academic Success means how well you are doing in school. If you have received a scholarship in the past but your GPA has dropped and you have received D's and F's since your last application, this may impact your scholarship.

Level of Service/Volunteering means how much and how long you have volunteered and is shown through your letter that states what you have done as a volunteer. The more detailed the letter, the better your chances of receiving a scholarship. Be sure to also describe your service clearly on the form and include dates and hours of service.

Extenuating Circumstances means that you have had additional obstacles to overcome, besides being an AB 540 student who receives no financial aid. It may be a large family size, having to take care of ill family members, etc.; basically, anything above the normal challenges of being a student.
