Board Policy

LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT

The District shall enter into a written agreement with the City of Glendale Police Department. The agreement shall clarify operational responsibilities for investigations of Part I violent crimes, defined by law to include willful homicide, forcible rape, robbery, and aggravated assault, sexual assault crimes, including, but not limited to rape, forced sodomy, forced oral copulation, rape by a foreign object, sexual battery, or threat of any of these; and also hate crimes, as defined by law, occurring at each campus location.

The written agreement shall designate whether the City of Glendale Police Department or the Glendale College Police Department shall have operational responsibility for violent crimes and delineate the specific geographical boundaries of each agency's operational responsibility, including maps as necessary.

The written agreements required by this policy shall be public records and shall be made available for inspection by members of the public upon request to the office of the Superintendent/President.
