### **Vice President of Student Services Announced**

I am pleased to announce that Dr. Paul Schlossman will become Vice President of Student Services effective June 4, 2018, subject to Board of Trustees approval May 15.

Dr. Schlossman has served Glendale Community College since 1998 as Associate Dean of Student Activities, Dean of Student Affairs, Acting Director of Communications and Marketing, and Acting Vice President of Student Services. He began his work in community colleges at MiraCosta College where he served as Student Services Coordinator and Coordinator of School Relations and Diversity Outreach Programs.

As Dean of Student Affairs, Dr. Schlossman is responsible for providing administrative leadership and support for the planning, development, and delivery of student support services. These include student outreach services, the welcome center, intercollegiate athletics, college scholarship program, student government and student activities, multicultural and community engagement center, service learning, and student judicial affairs.

Dr. Schlossman holds a Doctorate in Educational Leadership from UCLA; a Master's Degree in Public Administration from San Diego State University; and a Bachelor's Degree in Criminal Justice Administration from SDSU.
