<u>Val Dantzler</u> has served since September 2018 as Associate Vice President, Human Resources (Interim) at GCC. She has been HR Manager since 2005 and also teaches human resources management courses part-time at the college. Her previous experiences include five years as Senior Employee Relations Specialist with the Federal Reserve Bank in LA and four years as Senior Personnel /Training Specialist for TRW Systems Federal Credit Union. She has a Master of Business Administration and Bachelor of Science, Business Administration from University of La Verne and a Human Resource Management Certification from Cal Poly Pomona, Continuing Education Program.

<u>JaCenda Davidson</u> has served as the Vice President and Chief Human Resources Officer for two years and Director of Human Resources for nine years at Fisk University. Previously she was Employee Relations and Compensation Manager for seven years at University of the South. She earned an Education Doctor, Leadership and Professional Practice and Master of Arts, Organizational Management from Trevecca Nazarene University, and her Bachelor of Science, Organizational Management from Covenant College.

Annie Reed is Associate Dean, Employer-Employee Relations Special Assignments, Los Angeles Community College District and has served as College Ombudsman/Disciplinarian/EEO at Los Angeles Valley College since 2008. She earned her Juris Doctor and Bachelor of Science in Law degrees from University of West Los Angeles School of Law, a Masters in Psychology from Pepperdine University, and an Associate of Arts in Art from West Los Angeles College.
