Board Policy

COMMUNITY SERVICES PROGRAMS

The District shall maintain a community services program for the purpose of personal and professional development. Such classes shall be designated as community education classes open for admission to all adults. Some classes will be open to age-appropriate minors who can benefit from the program.

No General Fund monies may be expended to establish or maintain community services classes. Students involved in community services classes shall be charged a fee not to exceed the cost of maintaining the classes. Classes may also be offered for remuneration by contract or with contributions or donations of individuals or groups.
