PARENT PARTICIPATION CONTRACT DAY PROGRAM

hen parents are involved in their children's school, the children benefit and enjoy greater success, the families thrive, and a community of support develops. To this end, we encourage you to participate in as many events as your schedules allow. Attendance will be recorded, events publicized well in advance, with the expectation that you will be involved. Parents of children enrolled in the Laboratory School Day Program are required to sign this parent participation contract. Participation in the different activities of the CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER programs is vital to the success of our Center.

25 hours of Parent Participation is required, 11 of these are fulfilled in the mandatory events notes below. There are several options available to assist you in fulfilling your obligation. Parents may chose to complete the remaining 18 hours through participation in Events and Activities; by Donating Equipment or Services (at the discretion of the administration); or a combination of these. If parents find neither of these options fit their schedules, a Buy-Out option is available. Buy-out will be charged at the rate of \$500.00/year. It is the parent's obligation to have hours credited by having a staff member sign for the event, activity or donation.

The August **Orientation Meeting** with the Director and staff of the class your child will be entering in the school year is <u>Mandatory</u> (2 hours credit). **One parent must be attendance for this meeting in order for child to begin or stay in program.** It is <u>Mandatory</u> that one parent attend a PAGe meeting during the school year (2 hours credit) and set-up or clean-up for one event (2 hour credit). In addition, participation for the annual Spring Fundraiser is a 5 hour <u>Mandatory</u> event. Various options are available such as planning, working the day of the fundraiser, clean-up, set-up, and soliciting for donations.

The following is a partial list of some of the Events and Activities that will be available to you for Parent Participation. *Note*: Any family who "chairs" a committee automatically fulfills the remaining 18 hours participation obligation.
