## TENNIS COURT POLICIES AND ETIQUETTE

- 1. Courts are **ONLY** available to members on Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays (5:00 pm 10:00 pm), Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays (7:00 am–10:00 pm). Courts are **NOT** open to the public.
- 2. Giving tennis lessons is **NOT** allowed, if caught, membership may be revoked.
- 3. **6-ball maximum on courts 4, 5 and 6** when courts are in use.
- 4. The tennis pro, Deo Sy, is the only person who may give tennis lessons on these courts during the hours of club operation.
- 5. The club has an exclusive contract with a tennis professional. He gives lessons, sets up tournaments, holds clinics, sets up ladders and has limited supplies available.
- 6. Membership is for all family members <u>living at the same address</u>. Family members joining you are meant to be your playing partner. Children of appropriate age only allowed if playing. No toys, scooters, bikes or skate boards allowed.
- 7. When taking over a court, please wait outside the gate to be recognized. You are welcome to play the last game, but "no ad" scoring must be used.
- 8. Talk quietly when standing near tennis courts that are in use.
- 9. NO FOOD or DRINKS ALLOWED (water is the exception).
- 10. Please wipe down and clean benches before and after use of tennis court.
- 11. No music allowed at any time.
- 12. There is no required dress code on the courts; however, members are required to wear regulation tennis shoes. No jogging shoes or dark soled athletic shoes that mark or damage thecourts are allowed.
- 13. The Glendale College Tennis Team has permission to use courts 5 and 6 on Saturday, Sunday, and holidays from 2:00 p.m. 10:00 p.m.
- 14. Any behavior deemed aggressive in nature against another member and/or the tennis pro, will result in immediate membership forfeiture.

We realize there are many non-members entering the courts, we ask you to lock the gate behind you when done playing to reduce the number of non-members entering the courts.
