## Mentee Program Participation Requirements

- **Identify as LGBTQ+ (*you won't be outed!*)**
- **Attend a 1 hour orientation (*Orientation will be held on Thursday, September 23rd, 12:00 Noon to 1:00 p.m.*)**
- **Attend a GCC Safe Zone Training (during the academic year)**
- **Be validating and open to learning about ALL LGBTQ+ identities**
- **Be currently enrolled as a GCC credit or non-credit student**
- **Communicate with your mentor once a week (minimum)**
- **Attend mentor/mentee activities**

**All Activities and meetings will be remote (for the time being)**

## Mentee Responsibilities

- **Meet with mentor throughout the semester (at least once a week)**
- **Explore professional development issues related to your potential career choice with your mentor**
- **Work on developing connections with networks, people, and groups on campus**
- **Be willing to share your individual needs with your mentor**

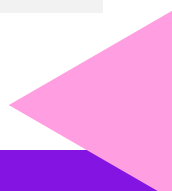
