*Applicants must be a college student enrolled in at least six (6) semester units with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or better at the time of hire *To maintain eligibility for continued employment, Cadet must be enrolled as a student in six (6) semester units or equivalent with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or better at an accredited college or university

Police Cadet

Completes a comprehensive training program designed to educate incumbents on the geography of the District's campuses as well as College Police and District policies, regulations, and operational procedures. Promotion to Police Senior Cadet upon successful completion of the training program.

Police Senior Cadet

Performs uniformed vehicle and foot patrol of District property to monitor activity; enforce parking regulations; and provide general assistance to students, employees, and visitors. Provides support for traffic control. Provides access to and locks buildings as directed. Completes lost and found property reports. Performs light clerical and customer services duties as necessary (e.g., filing, copying, answering phones, handling department mail). Performs related duties as assigned.

Police Cadet Corporal

Handles specialized duties including inventory of found property, cadet gear, and uniforms; delivery of reports and evidentiary items to Glendale PD and LASD; and the transport of vehicles to and from locations for maintenance and repair. In the absence of a Police Cadet Senior Corporal, may provide work direction to lower-level cadets. Performs related duties and duties of lower-level cadets as assigned.

Police Cadet Senior Corporal

Trains and provides work direction to lower-level cadets, reports performance issues to the Police Corporal in charge of the cadet program. Performs related duties and duties of lower-level cadets as assigned.
