



When you apply to UCSD, you will be asked to rank UCSD's Seven Colleges in the order of your preference. All seven colleges require you to complete additional general education requirements after you transfer to UCSD.

Your major is not related to the college you attend. Each college has their own mission and builds a sense of community for students. If you had started UCSD as a freshman, then your GEs would have been shaped by the mission of each college. This is not the same for transfers as your GEs are, in most cases, complete.

We believe students would be happy at any of the colleges even if they have to take a few extra classes with the exception of Revelle College. We have worked with students who sometimes have to take at least 8-10 additional courses because they selected Revelle College.

The ranking does not affect your chances of admission and does not matter as the additional courses are rather a matter of your interests. However, we suggest you select Revelle College last since it requires the most additional requirements, unless you are a STEM major. ## **MUIR COLLEGE**

Mission: Known for its welcoming, supportive community. Host many organizations and activities. Students are recognized for their individuality and independent spirit.

In addition to IGETC, must complete 1 upper division writing course.

### MARSHALL COLLEGE

Mission: Guides students of all majors and all interests to become highly engaged citizens committed to a better society. In addition to IGETC, must complete 2 upper division courses.

#### SIXTH COLLEGE

Mission: Preparing students to become dynamic and engaged citizens of the 21st century. In addition to IGETC, must complete 1 upper division practicum & 1 upper division course.

# ROOSEVELT COLLEGE

Mission: Developing world citizens through scholarship, leadership, and service. In addition to IGETC, must complete 2 lower division courses.

## **WARREN COLLEGE**

Mission: Acquire the intellectual, social, and decision-making skills needed to assume responsible citizenship in a global society. In addition to IGETC, must complete 1 upper division writing course & 2 upper division courses.

### **SEVENTH COLLEGE**

Mission: Strives to transform society by equipping the next generation of scholars, leaders, and innovators with the tools to confront our changing planet.

In addition to IGETC, must complete 2 lower division writing intensive courses & 1 upper division research project.

### **REVELLE COLLEGE**

Mission: Where the arts, sciences, and humanities join to inspire and educate Renaissance men and women.

Does not accept IGETC. Completion of IGETC will waive some general education requirements.

Must complete 1 year of Calculus or 2 quarter courses of Calculus and 1 quarter course from approved list, five courses of natural science, and all university graduation requirements.
